

Definition of "Family Pass" - A family membership includes up to a maximum of five (5) family members, residing at the same address, and is limited to four (4) adults, age 18 and older. Each additional family member: \$15/person

Grandparent Add-on - A grandparent may be added to a family, youth, or adult membership at half the price of a Sr. Citizen membership.

Nanny Add-on - A nanny / babysitter (age 18 or older), may be added to a family, youth, or adult membership at half the price of an adult membership.

When either a Grandparent or a Nanny attends the pool, he/she must show pass upon entry, and must be accompanied by a member of the family holding pass ownership. If the individual is not accompanied by a family member, the daily rate will be charged.

Military Discount - *Active* military personnel and family members showing proper military ID are eligible to receive a season pass or the daily rate at 50% off the regular price of admission.


